

The Oldenburg Town Council met December 3, 2021 at 7:00PM at the Town Hall. After being called to order by Pres. Dennis Moeller the minutes of the regular November meeting were read. Dave made a motion to accept minutes as read. Greg seconded it. Matt Stahley from Creek Bottom Brew was asking the council about adding Camp 35 Distillery to Creek Bottom Brew. He would make the mash on the farm and transport it to the taproom in order to ferment the mash in a small still and prepare it for distilling process in our bonded area in the taproom. There will not be any open flames ever in the building during the distilling process. When the mash would be ready, he would move it to the back parking lot roped area near a water source for cooling off (nothing, but clean water will run off) After the process is done, he is able to remove the spirits and waste and legally transport them back to the farm to age and be bottled due to the TTB Regulations. He said that Creek Bottom Brew would be co-owners of Camp 35 Distillery. This will all take time for state approval he is asking for the town to consider this. Town will need to check with insurance company. Will discuss at January meeting.

Jody with SEIRPC held our Pubic Hearing for OCRA Wastewater Grant \$480,130. The town made a commitment of \$50,000 for matching from ARP and the Utility has their match.

Tom Black said he raised funds of \$2,100 for 3 Flagpoles and Landscaping. He may have to cut on the landscaping due to funding. He will order the flagpoles from Abbott. Dave made a motion to move forward Denny seconded.

Dylan Walmsley asked if he needed approval for a new sign in front of his building. 48 X 96 (4x4 individual signs attached) He's basically replaced the old sign with the same size. The board said he could go ahead and put it up.

Denny reported the Mayor of Batesville said they were going for funding for a walking path from Batesville to Oldenburg.

Denny, Dave and Greg signed an Inter Local Agreement relating to utility services and snow removal in Oldenburg. The county will provide snow removal for the town and the town will reimburse Franklin County for the sand and salt used.

Denny reported he had Mike Gehring from Gehring, Inc. work on the Rooftop furnace and the basement furnace in the Municipal Building. It will cost around \$2,900.

The white ford truck is having problems again. Brakes, Battery, Power Steering. Oldenburg Service talked to Dave on what needed to be done. The council will have Daron Duerstock give it a look over to see what all needed to be done to get it fixed. Then the council will decide next step.

Bill had a dog nuisance complaint about dogs barking all the time on main street.

First Reading of the 2022 Salary Ordinance.


