

The Oldenburg Town Council met November 1, 2021 at 7:00PM at the Town Hall. After being called to order by Pres. Dennis Moeller the minutes of the regular October were read. Dave made a motion to accept minutes as read. Denny seconded it. Greg was absent.

Greg Ronnebaum had the lease agreement for the Eagle Fire Company for the Town Council to sign. Denny and Dave renewed the lease for Eagle Fire Co for the year of 2022 for \$1.00.

Mary McCarty reported on the Federal Sewer Grant to be filed for by December 17, 2021. Gave some ideas on how to approve our score. Raise matching fund,

The Council agreed to add to the matching fund of \$50,000. John will check to see if ARP money is eligible to be used as a match.

Jeff report that the bucket truck that was used to put up xmas lights is no longer available.

Denny will check with Batesville.

Denny had a letter about the Opioids suit that the town was entitled to be a part of. John agreed.

Cindy reported that INDOT needs an Ordinance passed for electronic signatures allowing the Town Council President Authority to be the legal signer for the Town.

Denny informed the Council that the Creek Bottom Brew will have a ribbon cutting celebrating their first anniversary on November 13, with a food truck vendor and music.

Jeff report that instead on Xmas under the Spires this year it will be call Light Up Oldenburg.


