

The Oldenburg Town Council met October 3, 2022 at 7:00PM at the Town Hall. After being called to order by Pres. Dennis Moeller the minutes of the regular September meeting were read. Greg made a motion to accept minutes as read. Dave seconded.

#### Building Permits

Ashley Meyer needed a building permit for updating his electric and plumbing before Franklin County could come and inspect it. 3022 Pearl Street, Oldenburg. Greg made a motion to approve Building Permit #1399. Dave and Denny seconded.

Dustin Hertel asked for a permit to build a 2- Car Garage with a deck above it. 32' X 32'. 22172 Main Street, Oldenburg. Greg made a motion to approve Building Permit #1400. Dave and Denny seconded.

Jim Meyer had questions on celebrating the 20<sup>th</sup> year of Christmas under the Spires. He would like to have live reindeers from Whitetail Acres for the celebration. He asked about closing the street from Pearl to the park or Vine. They would lay a tarp on the street for the reindeers and will clean everything up. Setup 8:30 Reindeer from 9-11 Clean up by 11:30. Bill would like the road closed to Vine. He also said they will be having a train for the kids to ride and the Horse and Carriage. They also would like to hang a banner of the foot bridge and put up a sign by the Oldenburg sign coming into Oldenburg. The council agreed they could do it.

Jeff reported on the Utility Grant that they were requesting release of funds. Paperwork had to be in by October 11, 2022.

Jeff reported that a globe on one décor light in the park was broke. Greg will get a hold of Hanover Lighting 717 632 6464, also the lights outside the restrooms at the town hall don't put out much light suggested upgrading to LED.

The second budget hearing was held. Greg made a motion to pass the 2023 budget. Dave & Denny seconded. Passed.




