The Oldenburg Town Council met August 2, 2021 at 7:00PM at the Town Hall. After being called to order by Pres. Dennis Moeller the minutes of the regular June meeting were read. Dave made a motion to accept minutes as read. Greg seconded it.

There was no July meeting due to lack of quorum.

Tom Black had a drawing of his proposed flag pole and landscaping at the Municipal Building. The next step was to send in his proposal to the BSA for approval and then fund raising. He hopes to be able to start this fall. The council approved of his plans.

Megan Roope, Margaret Mary Health was asking the town to get involved with Paint the Town Pink for the month of October for breast cancer awareness. MM Health will furnish banners to be hung on Pearl Street. She suggested getting the community involved with decorating their store fronts or homes, hanging pink ribbons. The council gave her approval to order the banners with Denny calling her with measurements.

Sister Claire informed the town they were dissolving or OREC Committee. She asked if we could leave up the Greenhouse survey on the town web-site. The council thanked her and the committee for all their hard work.

Mr. Kunkel gave the town his ideas on how to fix the creek from the last two floods. He thought bigger riprap would help. He estimated around \$19,000 but will get a bid to the councilman. He would be able to start Oct/Nov.

Dylan Wamsly reviewed his thought on the gutters and bell tower. He will try to have a bid to the council by the 14th to see if this is even feasible.

Mike Tekulve wanted to tap into the storm sewer. The council could not find that a fee was ever charged to be able to hook into. There is not hookup fee.

Denny reported Werner was finishing up with the storm sewer replacement behind Werner's. Cindy reported that the CCMG Grant was submitted on July 21st. Project amount \$270,117.00 CCMG \$202,587.75 Town match \$67,529.25. Water Street (St Mary's Road to Dead end) Vine Street (Washington St to SR 229 SB) Indiana (Water St – Dead end).

September meeting will be Monday, Sept 13, 2021 at 7:00PM.

Jeff asked the town if some of the ARP money could be used to help fund a GIS Mapping system for the Town. The council was interested in it. Jeff will set up a meeting with the GIS Mapping company and let the council know when it is.

Doug informed the council that the police received a grant from Giving Hearts a Hand, for a AED defibulator. They will keep it up at the Municipal Building in the Police Department and will take it in their patrol cars while patrolling.

The council gave their input with the up coming budget along with the Police Department with raises, needs and future project funding. Cindy's budget meeting is August 18th.

After the July and August claims were read and approved, the meeting was adjourned.
