

The Oldenburg Town Council met Monday, April 6, 2026 at 7:00 PM at the Municipal Building meeting room. After being called to order by President Brian Clagg, the minutes from the previous March 2, 2026 meeting were approved. Councilman Kerker made a motion to approve, Councilman Wahman seconded. All in favor. Next the minutes from the March 26, 2026 Special Meeting minutes were accepted. Councilman Kerker made a motion to approve, Councilman Wahman seconded. All in favor.

First, town member Jason Hunter requested a building permit for a deck off the back of his house approximately 20' deep and 50' wide using composite decking material. Questions regarding grading for drainage. Motion to approve made by Councilman Wahman. Seconded by Councilman Kerker.

Next, town attorney John Kellerman swore-in a new reserve deputy, Officer Marc Dennett, and town council members welcomed the new addition to the town's police force.

Next, Clerk Treasurer Hunter discussed updated filing requirements by the Department of Local Government & Finance (DLGF) in order to request an additional appropriation. Because an Ordinance was already passed in January, a motion to approve the Amended Ordinance with updated signatures and dates was made by Councilman Kerker, seconded by Councilman Wahman. All in favor.

President Clagg discussed his continued attempts to follow-up with Duke representative, to no avail. Hunter will add Duke to the May agenda.

Next, two Franklin County Area Planning, Zoning & Building Department amendments were reviewed and explained by attorney Kellerman and signed and dated by President Clagg. Motion to adopt made by Councilman Kerker, seconded by Councilman Wahman. All in favor.

Next, Clagg discussed insurance coverage for the Oldenburg T-ball League. After a recent review of insurance, it was agreed that the league should have liability insurance. Bill Vankirk relayed that the cost is \$500 for a 6 month \$1M liability policy. A motion to accept the fee for coverage was made by Councilman Kerker, seconded by Councilman Wahman. All in favor.

Next, President Clagg discussed the recent leak to the firehouse roof. Innovative Roofing was able to come take a look, and made repairs. CT Hunter awaiting invoice.

Clagg gave the annual Fire Territory meeting notice which will be held Tuesday, April 14th @ 6:30 PM.

Next, Council and Clerk discussed the sale of the 2009 Ford Crown Victoria and the required notice of sale. After discussions with Marshal Boesken and Deputy Marshal Wolfer, the vehicle would not yet be ready for sale due to the police equipment within. Hunter will add the item for further discussion to the May agenda.

Lastly, Clerk Treasurer Hunter mentioned the Franklin County Community Foundation, Stan & Helen Enneking Grant Funds received in the amount of \$1,170.00. A thank you note was signed.
