

The Oldenburg Town Council met January 2, 2024 at 7:00PM at the Town Hall. After being called to order by President Dennis Moeller, the minutes of the regular December meeting, wrap-up meeting and the Additional Appropriation meeting were read. Dave made a motion to accept minutes as read, Greg seconded.

The new council appointments:

Dennis Moeller – President – Gregory Struewing – Vice President – John Kellerman – Attorney

Moenter – Deputy – Doug Wolfer – Reserve Officer.

1. Tim Hunt updated the council on the Federal Grant and had an LPA Consulting Contract for Supplement #1 to the Federal Grant to be signed by council. This is to look at the historic value of the culvert on water street. Tim had discussion with Mary at INDOT to help finance Supplement #1. Extra cost of \$145,150. Mary agreed funds were available. Council signed contract. 80 – 20 Match
2. Grant Knollman addressed the board again about making changes to the skateboard ordinance. He said everyone shouldn't be punished for the few bad ones. After a long discussion the council agreed to have John reword the skateboard ordinance and to allow it on a trial basis of 6 months.
3. Denny informed the council the town received the Next Level Trail Grant for \$409,000. It's for trails across the creek along Harvey's Branch to the Girls Ball Diamond. He thanked Jeff Paul & Gary Munchel for applying for this grant on behalf of the Town. The Frudenfest is paying for the match.
4. Jeff and Gary also said they are interested in the Ready 2.0. It's and 80/20 match. For resurfacing the basketball court to include pickleball, shelter, landscaping. Working with Mary McCarty and John Palmer. Gary also was going to apply for FCCF for the small grant of \$3,000 for trees across creek.
5. Jeff and Dave said some of the trees need to be trimmed along Harvey's Branch, also by Town Hall and the Municipal Building. The council asked Dave to contact Enzingers for a bid and to see which ones need to be done.
6. Father Carl invited the citizens of Oldenburg to attend the ceremony to ordain Brother John. January 20th at 10:00AM with a bunch to follow. RSVP are needed.
7. Bill said he received a check for \$5,000 from Ray Township Joe Herbert to go toward upgrading their radio's.
8. Denny had a letter from Kaitlin Sterwerf, Franklin County Area Plan Commission to pass an amendment- additions:

Section 80.03.05: R-2 Single-Family and Two-Family Residence District


Section 80.03.06: R-3 Multi-Family Residence District


Section 80.03.07: G-B General Business District
