

The Oldenburg Town Council met July 1, 2024 at 7:00 PM at the Town Hall. After being called to order by Councilman Struewing as President Moeller was on vacation. Councilman Wahman made a motion to approve last months' minutes, and Councilman Struewing seconded the approval.

Dan Weigel requested to close a portion of Pearl Street sometime in August for a fire truck foam party from Negangard's rentals. The foam party would last approximately 90 minutes. There is no cost to the town for this event, no police presence required, and he does not plan to advertise the event. Councilman Wahman made a motion to approve and Councilman Struewing seconded the approval.



Discussion continued regarding grass ordinance and the process for issuing violation notices.


After the claims were read and approved, the meeting was adjourned.
