

The Oldenburg Town Council met April 4, 2022 at 7:00PM at the Town Hall. After being called to order by Pres. Dennis Moeller the minutes of the regular February meeting were read. Greg made a motion to accept minutes as read, Dave & Denny seconded.

Carrie and Jodi from SEIRPC updated the council on the CDBG Sewer Grant and had their contract to be signed for their services to oversee this grant of \$43,100.00 Greg made a motion to sign contract, Denny and Dave seconded.

Denny informed the council he went out on bids for trash pick up in Oldenburg due to notification from WM that they were increasing their services by a significant amount. He had two bids one from WM & Rumpke. Best Way declined to bid.

WM was 13.95 a month per household then 7% raise each year. \$8 extra toter.

Rumpke \$13.50 a month per household with toter and no fuel charge or 12.50 without toter with a 5% raise each year. Extra toter would be \$3.50 billed directly to homeowner. Dean from Rumpke was present. Greg made a motion to go with Rumpke and \$13.50 with toter for a 3 year contract. Dave and Denny seconded. The council would raise household pick up to \$10 first year, \$13 second year and \$15 3rd year.

Denny asked if the council gave any more thought for the ARP money. \$50,000 is to be used for part of the match for the sewer project. Dave and Greg said they would like to use it to repair the town hall roof and cupola. Denny would like to see adding lights to basketball court, shelter, grills and parking lot across the creek by maypole. The council voted to repair the roof and cupola.

Doug asked the council about upgrade the internet at the Municipal Building from copper to fiber optic. Great Plains said it would be a fire stick \$15 more a month plus taxes.

He also reported the Truck was being made.

Denny said David Mannix is resigning from the BZA Appeals Board due to living out of state part of the year and no virtual meetings anymore. Denny said he would fill the spot unless they could find someone else.

The utility plant had roof damage from the last storm. Denny will be meeting with the insurance company.

Denny read 4 amended ordinances from Franklin Co Area Planning , Cindy Orschell for the town to adopt.
