

The Oldenburg Town Council met May 2, 2022 at 7:00PM at the Town Hall. After being called to order by Pres. Dennis Moeller the minutes of the regular February meeting were read. Dave made a motion to accept minutes as read, Denny seconded.

Ryan Paul from Paul Landscaping was present with his new contract for 2022. He would do the upkeep of the towns landscaping for the entire year for \$7,575.00 which includes a one time fee of \$150 free for extra mulch by the trees along the creek. It would be in effect from May 1, 2022 until April 30, 2023. Dave made a motion to approve the contract Denny seconded.

Dave Mannix informed the Council he was resigning from the BZA. Denny can't take the seat because he is an elected official. We need to find someone who would be interested in representing Oldenburg.

Richard Orr informed he was going for a variance May 11<sup>th</sup> at Franklin County to be able to build a second story on the old pet grooming building. Dave said it would be a great improvement. The council is in support of this. Denny will call Cindy Orschell and let her know that Oldenburg supports this.

Paul Brock was needing a building permit to build a 12 X 24 above ground pool. Dave made a motion to approve building permit #1-1396. Denny seconded.


