The Oldenburg Town Council met March 1, 2021 at 7:00PM at the Town Hall. After being called to order by Pres. Dennis Moeller the minutes of the regular February meeting were read. Dave made a motion to accept minutes as read. Greg seconded it.

Melanie Stahley from Creek Bottom Brew asked the council about having a Grand Opening in April or May. Blocking parking lot off in back for outdoor seating. Will need to get special one day licenses for outdoor drinking. Would like to include local restaurants. Maybe asking church to use their parking lot or maybe the field off Hamburg road. The board does not see a problem with this as long as there is parking for the police. She will look into further and get back with the council.

Denny reported the town did not receive any federal funds this round. Will talk to Tim from HWC about next steps.

The water and sewer bill was discussed. Decision was made that Oldenburg Utility would bill Creek Bottom Brew for the sewer and water used in the municipal building back to August 2020. The lease will be adjusted by \$25 to make it \$625.00 a month, this will adjust for the town use of water and sewer in the building. The will be included in the updated lease. Dave made a motion for the Utility to bill Creek Bottom Brew and the town to adjust the lease by \$25 for town use. Greg and Denny seconded.

Jeff Paul and Troy Idlerton asked the council if the town would consider buying new banners for the décor light poles. 33 WeatherGuard at \$124 each plus shipping. The Fruedenfest has bought these in the past but since covid hit they have not been able to hold the festival and funds are low. Greg made a motion to purchase new banners for the towns décor light poles. Dave and Denny seconded.

Denny said there are two trees in the park that need trimmed or taken down due to dead spot. Enzingers thought they were solid enough not to remove. He had three bids Kurtz Lawn Care for \$1,640 Trim \$2,500 Removal, Arbor \$800 Trim \$2,600 Removal, Enzingers \$800 Trim. Greg would like for him and Denny to take a look at them before they are trim or removed. Cindy reported receiving two checks. One from SE IN Solid Waste District for recycling & FCCF in memory of Stan Enneking for beautification of Oldenburg.

After the claims were read and approved, the meeting was adjourned.
