



The Oldenburg Town Council met October 2, 2023 at 7:00PM at the Town Hall. After being called to order by Pres. Dennis Moeller the minutes of the regular September meeting were read. Greg made a motion to accept minutes as read, Dave seconded.

1. Jim Meyer asked the council about closing the road between Main & Vine for Xmas Under the Spires, December 2, 2023, from 12:00PM to 5:00PM. Reindeers 12:00 to 2:00PM, Creek Bottom Brewery, Music and maybe a train, Carriage Ride. The Council gave permission to close the street.
2. Denny reported that Chris Munchel resigned from the BZA Appeals Board. He told the council that Tom Wodtke, has agreed to replace Chris on the BZA. Greg made a motion to appoint Tom to the BZA Board, Denny & Dave agreed. Cindy will send information about the appointment.
3. Dave reported that Ralph L Stephenson & Co, were going to start work on the Town Hall next week.
4. Greg had a bid from Rohe on paving the Municipal Building parking lot for \$29,035.20. Werner Concrete for replacing the retaining wall, Section 1, 136 Feet \$42,000.00. Section 2 behind the Municipal Bldg. The Council would like to meet with Mr. Werner for questions and more options. The council decided to wait on both project until they meet with Mr. Werner. Council also would like to get Municipal Building lot surveyed. Denny will get ahold of a surveyor.
5. Denny asked John about the Ordinance for CCI. He is working on one. He will add this project to the Ordinance.
6. Denny updated the Council about the meeting held September 25, 2023 on the Federal Grant project for the box culvert on Water Street. Historic Preservation Society is giving their opinion on Historic Value. Nothing can be done until we hear back from them.
7. Denny had a call from Eric Feller about two big sinkholes in his yard from piping put in when Franklin County replaced the bridge on Vote Road. Who is responsible for this? Denny will get ahold of Franklin County Highway Engineer.
8. Denny signed the renewal for the Town Insurance coverage. Bill Vankirk went with Toskio Marine Insurance for 14,222 compared to 17,000.00.
9. Denny said Steve Amrhein called him and asked if the Town would vacate Douglas Street to 229 that goes thru his yard or sell it or lease it to him. After discussion the Council voted NO.
10. Sister Claire reported on the EARTH Project. They are having a meeting on October 27th, 2023 from 11:00AM to 1PM with lunch being served. She wanted to invite the council to attend. She said they were suggesting five to seven sites to be a focal point on save electricity. One site was the Wastewater Plant.

After the claims were read and approved, the meeting was adjourned.
