

The Oldenburg Town Council met February 1, 2021 at 7:00PM at the Town Hall. After being called to order by Pres. Dennis Moeller the minutes of the regular January meeting were read. Greg made a motion to accept minutes as read. Denny seconded.

Sara Collins representing the Sisters of St Francis had a letter asking the board to pass a parking ordinance. Cars are being parked on Washington Street for a long period of time and taking up parking spacing by the Academy's entrance. Employees park on that street along with students. The Council said it was a public the street and as long as they are licensed they could park there. Council suggested the sisters putting a letter on the subject vehicles and explaining the situation and maybe they would move them.

Bill Vankirk presented the Oldenburg Police with a \$1,200.00 Grant from IPEP for Public Safety use. Doug & Cindy applied for this grant in December 2020. The Police match is \$300.00.

Ryan Paul Landscape had a bid to landscape the curve on Indiana Avenue. Greg's concern with the plan was it was too busy. Took much to look at going around the curve, afraid of causing accidents. Denny and Greg & Ryan will look at it further. Greg made a motion to close skateboard park idea. No funding and enforcement. Denny seconded.

Kurtz Lawn Care was given the mowing and creek spraying contract for 2021.

Ryan Paul Landscape was given the landscaping contract for 2021.

Denny asked Father Carl about lighting the side parking lot up for the safety of the religion children. He said he would talk to Doug about this.

OA informed the Council they would be widening the entrance to the Feldhouse. The taproom asked about the town putting up blinds in the taproom. Council said they could put them up if they wanted them but the town would not.

Doug had a bid for two new radios from Baltus in Greensburg. 2 Kenwood \$3000.00. Bill received \$5,000 from Ray Township to be used for Public Safety. Greg made a motion to purchase 2 radios.

Cindy had the 2020 Financial Statement for the Council to approve. Denny made a motion to approve. Greg seconded.

After the claims were read and approved the meeting was adjourned.
