A special town meeting was held on March 27, 2025 at 7:00 PM at the Municipal Building meeting room in order to review Oldenburg Academy's fundraising project for "Beautifying the Burg" and to discuss the Walking Trail Bids received.

Jason Walke with Oldenburg Academy and students M.V. and K.S. announced they have raised \$30,405.00 ahead of their \$25,000 match from the State. Their goal is to have the basketball court updated first, prior to the walking trail. Park benches and landscaping to be discussed at a later date, depending on additional funding received. The students plan to continue raising money. State funding stipulates must break ground sometime after June 2025 and must be completed prior to June 2026.

Discussion moved forward to the bid estimates received for resurfacing the basketball court. Gary Munchel and Jeff Paul (vai speaker phone,) discussed estimates obtained by Jeff Paul in order to complete the project: fencing is projected to be an additional \$18,000, paint to stripe the courts, \$16,000, and the cost of 2 nets is estimated at \$6,000.00. The Leising bid received was \$63k (+\$40k), and the Rohe bid received was \$43k (+\$40k). Gary and councilman held further discussion regarding the additional \$75k budgeted from Town. Budget and bid breakdown sheet, provided by Gary Munchel is attached.

Discussion regarding merits of both companies and both bids.

Councilman Clagg made motion to adjourn, and Councilman Wahman seconded.
