

The Oldenburg Town Council met September 13, 2021 at 7:00PM at the Town Hall. After being called to order by Pres. Dennis Moeller the minutes of the regular August meeting were read. Dave made a motion to accept minutes as read. Greg seconded it.

Eric introduced Dalton Mosher. He will be joining the Oldenburg Police Department as a new reserve officer. John swore him in.

Denny said he attended a few BZA meeting in David Mannix's place. The BZA board would like a letter stating Denny could represent the Town of Oldenburg on the BZA Board when David is unable to attend. Cindy will send a letter.


Jeff informed the council that they were not awarded the grant. Denny, Utility Board and Mary McCarty will meet with OCRA to see what they need to improve for the next round of applications. Will need another income survey. The board approved to reapply and to past the Ordinance needed. Greg made a motion to apply, Denny & Dave seconded.

Denny reported that the insurance company would only pay for the lights and benches damaged in the flood. We have a \$500 deductible so we should receive a check for \$900.

Denny will call Laker's to go ahead and repair lights along with the sign at the bottom of the hill and will order new bench.

The board approve for Mr. Kunkel to go ahead and fix the flood damage in the creek plus a few extras for \$25,000.00.

First reading of the 2022 Budget was read. Second budget meeting will be October 4, 2021 at 7:00PM at the Town Hall.
