

The Oldenburg Town Council met December 5, 2022 at 7:00PM at the Town Hall. After being called to order by President Dennis Moeller the minutes of the regular November meeting were read. Dave made a motion to accept minutes as read. Greg and Denny seconded.

Steve Stahley, Creek Bottom Brew asked the council about moving the 811 sign from one wall to another so he could put up a 48x32 sign with Creek Bottom Brew on it. Only sign displayed is the Tap Room up on top and customers don't really know it's the Brewery. They council wanted to take a look at it first but thought it would be ok.

He also informed the council that Cummins has Grants available from \$25,000 to \$100,000. For Infra structure (Solar, Water Conservation) 3 months turnaround. He said if the council was interested, he would get more info and come back to the council. The council said they were interested.

Denny asked Dave if he has gotten a bid from the Steeple guys. He said no but they were interested in the job. His name was Randy Stephenson. Denny will give him a call.

Denny reported that Chris Munchel agreed to sit on the BZA board. Greg made a motion for Chris Munchel to represent the town of the BZA board. Dave & Denny seconded. Cindy will send a letter.

Denny reported that Cindy Orschel said that elected officials could sit on the APC Board. Denny agreed to represent the Town for the year of 2023. Greg made a motion for Denny to represent the Town of the APC Board. Dave seconded

Greg made a motion to have Denny represent the Town of the SIRPC again. Dave seconded.

The first reading of the 2023 Salary Ordinance was read. Second reading will be December 20th.

John report that the Insurance company was sending a check for the Vote Road damage.

Cindy reported the 2023 budget was approved. The Fire Territory was decreased by \$7,490.00 Was asking \$149,759 approved \$142,260.

Cindy reported that the CCMG Grant project by Globe was under budget by \$12,128.45.

We will have to refund \$9,096.34 to INDOT and transfer back to MVH \$3,032.11. Cindy asked permission to transfer back to MVH.

Jeff reported they have three new Utilitiy Board members. David Raver, Dustin Nobbe & Ashley Meyer.

After the claims were read and approved, the meeting was adjourned.

The wrap up meeting was held December 20, 2023, at 7:00PM at the Town Hall.

Second reading of the Salary Ordinance was read. Greg made a motion to pass Salary Ordinance 1-2023 to be in effect for January 1, 2023. Denny and Dave seconded.



Denny asked Greg if he would be will to help out if he was not available due to removing snow for Kurtz's. Greg agreed to fill in. The municipal building and parking lot by recycle bins would need to be cleared.



ORDINANCE # 1 – 2023


BE IT ORDAINED by the Town council of Oldenburg, Franklin County, Indiana, that the following be enacted as the salary ordinance for the Town of Oldenburg.

- Section 1: That the salary of the Town Council members \$3,600.00 per year each.
Section 2: That the salary of the Clerk-Treasurer \$13,500.00 per year. General Fund \$13,000.00 SW Franklin Co. Fire Territory \$500.00.
Section 3: That the salary of the Town Marshal \$24,034.44 per year. General Fund Deputy \$9,056.21 per year. General Fund Total Police \$33,090.65.
Section 4: That the salary of the Utility Clerk 9,600.00 per year.
Section 5: That the hourly wage for Misc work for the Town be \$7.25 per hr.
Section 6: That the salary of the Town Hall Cleaner \$600.00 per year.
Section 7: That the Utility Board Members shall receive \$25.00 per meeting attended.

These changes shall be in full force and effective, January 1, 2023.


