

The Oldenburg Town Council met October 4, 2021 at 7:00PM at the Town Hall. After being called to order by Pres. Dennis Moeller the minutes of the regular August meeting were read. Dave made a motion to accept minutes as read. Greg seconded it.

Tim & Jacob from HWC Engineering reported on Water Street Project. Bridge is Historical select 2010, which add a twist to the Federal Application. They presented the board with three options, after discussion Greg made a motion to apply for Option A-B3, Dave and Denny seconded. Tim will talk with Franklin County Commissioners to see what they are willing to do and set up a meeting with both to discuss the bridge and how much the Town could help with the match for the bridge.

Dylan Wamsley discussed his bid with the council. The council said at this time it is higher than they want to commit to. They told him they are going out for other bids and then will discuss at a later date. Both agreed something need to be done.

John Kunkel wanted an ok from the council to go ahead and start the creekbank cleanup & repairs. The board said to go ahead.

Jeff Meadows asked for a building permit to build an 18'X20' deck on his house at 3033 Washington Street. Made of composite wood. The board advised him to call 811 for underground utilities. Greg made a motion to grant building permit #1-1394. Dave & Denny seconded.


Denny reported Green Acres plan on building an Education Center on St. Mary's Road in the future.


Cindy reported we needed to file the ARP Plan by October 31, 2021.
