Tim Hunt from HWC had proposals for CCMG for July's application. To mill and HMA Overlay with ADA Improvements Water Street to dead end, and Mill and HMA Overlay on Vine Street - Washington Street to 229SB. Rough estimate of \$232,362.00. Will discuss more at June's meeting.

Thomas Black was exploring projects that he could do in The Town of Oldenburg for his Eagle Scout Service Project. Project to be between \$1,500 - \$2000. The council will look for ideas before the June 7th meeting.




Denny reported they approved the Fire Territory Budget for 2022.
